**MEDIEVAL GIRONA AND THE SALVADOR DALI MUSEUM IN FIGUERAS**



Just 100 km north of Barcelona is the enchanting city of Girona. This city has the oldest and best preserved Jewish Quarter of any city outside of Israel. Also worth visiting is the cathedral which houses the unique 'Tapestry of the Creation'. From Girona it is just a short drive to Figueras and the Dali Museum.

Can you imagine a museum that looks like a giant hen that has just laid some enormous eggs? Or a convertible Cadillac inside of which it actually rains? These are just two of the weird and wonderful exhibits you can find at the Dali Museum.

**THE MODERNIST/WORLD OF GAUDI TOUR**

Barcelona is considered to be the best open-air museum of Modernist art and architecture in Europe.



Visit some of the famous streets in the Ensanche and see some of the 150 buildings designated to be of particular artistic and historical merit by the autonomous government of Catalonia.

Antoni Gaudi is considered to be the most talented and innovative of the Modernist architects. Gaudi created his own unique style. Visit some of his most impressive creations:the Batlló House,the Milá House, Park Güell, and his unfinished masterpiece The Holy Family Church.

Length of tour:4-5 hours depending on how many stops are made to visit the interior of the buildings.

This tour is recommended for visitors who are particularly interested in Gaudi's life and work and wish to learn more about some of Barcelona's most fascinating buildings.
